As a presenter, you can receive up to 2/3 funding for our programs from the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs (DCA) in the following counties: Baker, Bradford, Calhoun, Columbia, DeSoto, Dixie, Franklin, Gadsden, Gilchrist, Glades, Gulf, Hamilton, Hardee, Hendry, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lafayette, Levy, Liberty, Madison, Nassau, Okeechobee, Putnam, Suwannee, Taylor, Union, Wakulla, Walton, Washington. 1/3 funding from the State is available to all other Florida counties.
